Assemblymember Nguyen and Sacramento County District Attorney Thien Ho Holds Press Conference on Mental Health Diversion – Attempted Murder

Sacramento — Assemblymember Stephanie Nguyen will hold a press conference on Thursday, April 25, 2024, to address her bill on Mental Health Diversion – Attempted Murder, sponsored by the California District Attorneys Association (CDAA) and co-sponsored by the Crime Victims United (CVU). This bill aims to add attempted murder to the list of crimes ineligible for mental health diversion.

“This bill is needed not only in Sacramento but statewide. There are cases where someone attempts murder and gets released back into the community without being held accountable,” Assemblymember Stephanie Nguyen said. “Those who attempt a violent act to end someone’s life should serve their sentence in addition to receiving their mental health diversion.”
