Public Health says “Come on Down!” to Tomorrow’s H1N1 Clinic at the Florin Road Toyota Building

(Sacramento, CA) – Sacramento County Public Health is holding its next community H1N1 flu vaccination clinic tomorrow, December 9th, at 3800 Florin Road, Sacramento, in a building formerly occupied by Florin Road Toyota.

The clinic hours will be from 3:00-7:00 PM and all Sacramento County residents are welcome to get their H1N1 vaccination free of charge.

“I want to especially remind residents to dress warmly in hats, coats and gloves because of the chilly temperatures Sacramento is experiencing,” said Sacramento County Health Officer Glennah Trochet, M.D. “The line for the clinic forms outdoors, and we are expecting unusually cold weather. It is not necessary to get in line too early. One hour before the clinic begins is soon enough,” Trochet said.

The Public Health staff, which has conducted a dozen vaccination clinics since November 16th, will transform the empty auto dealership into a clinic site and hopes to vaccinate 2,000 County residents during the four-hour period. The large lot offers plenty of parking. Additional parking will be available at nearby Luther Burbank High School after 5:00 PM.

The site also contains a complete schedule of all the H1N1 clinics, as well as a consent form that is required for vaccination. You can download the form in advance and bring it with you to save time at the clinic.
