Sacramento County Takes Eighth as Top U.S. Digital County

Sacramento, CA -- The top 10 most technologically-advanced county governments in the United States have been named by the [Center for Digital Government](#) and the [National Association of Counties \(NACo\)](#) in their 2012 Digital Counties Survey. Sacramento County took eighth place honors in the 500,000 or more population category.

Counties from around the U.S. participated in the 2012 Digital Counties Survey that evaluated more than 100 measurements and data points about online customer service delivery, IT architecture, efficiencies and governance models to demonstrate the strategic use of technology.

Sacramento County Chief Information Officer Rami Zakaria, said, "Our County has done a tremendous job in continually looking for ways to use technology to not only benefit our citizens, but to use it in a way that streamlines processes and is most cost efficient. I am very proud of our tech-advances and innovations, and I am looking forward to our many new IT initiatives that will further help our constituents, save money, reduce manual processes and increase transparency."
